



Initial Teacher Training

1 Scope

The School aims to provide for the personal and professional care and development of all members of the school staff, including student teachers. The purpose of Initial Teacher Training in the school is to work in partnership with Higher Education establishments in line with DfEE requirements, to make a real contribution to the profession by ensuring that students are thoroughly prepared and, in the process, to provide professional development for the tutors.

2 Requirements

The School will, therefore,

1. establish partnership arrangements with Higher Education institutions, following consultation and agreement over funding and procedures, for one year in the first instance;
2. expect its Professional Tutor to
 - liaise with HE institutions over the placement of students;
 - oversee students' work on teaching practice;
 - contribute to students' professional studies;
 - co-ordinate assessments and reports;
- 3 expect its Subject Tutors to
 - plan and supervise students' teaching practice within their faculties;
 - liaise with the Professional Tutor and HE institutions over students' progress, assessment and welfare.

Training for the varying ITT programmes is provided for the Professional Tutors, mentors and Co-ordinator by the appropriate HE institution.
