

## Year 4 Lesson Explanations for Monday 23.03.20

Good morning everyone! I'm so disappointed I can't see you today, I'm going to miss you all. I'm not sure yet what your work will look like in the near future, but here are some activities to start you off. If you don't have a printer at home, then use the books you were given last week to complete the learning in. Below are some short instructions for each of the tasks you have been given:

### **Arithmetic:**

Use your column addition methods to work out the sums. Don't forget to carry over if it's more than 9.

### **Maths:**

A nice one to start off your first day of home learning, use your place value knowledge to work out 1000 more or 1000 less. Don't forget to pay attention to whether it is a '+' sign or a '-' sign.

### **SPaG:**

Expanded noun phrases help our writing by giving it more description and painting a picture for the reader. Follow the instructions on the sheet. If you can't print, practise your beautiful handwriting by copying the sentences into your book.

### **Literacy:**

Haikus – we love 'em. Practise your poetry by creating haikus for each of the seasons of the year. Don't forget the first line has 5 syllables, the second line has 7 and the last line has 5 again. Try not to repeat words, and if you can make the lines flow into each other, that will improve your style :)

### **Topic:**

I was hoping to teach you all about how cubism (a type of art) was inspired by music. You could try researching this yourself, or just have a go using the sheet to help you and a blank piece of paper to create your own art. If you don't have a dice at home, just choose the features you want!
