Issues identified as barriers to learning from Sept 2020	
A1	Pupils were in lockdown from March-September 2020 closing to all except KW and V pupils
A2	Progress score in KS2 needs improvement for Reading, writing and maths from 2019 SATs
A3	Maths results in KS2 in 2019 3% below national (76% compared with national of 79%)
A4	Maintaining strong communication with parents when we cannot have face to face discussions
A5	Children have higher levels of anxiety due to lockdown and the pandemic
A6	Pupils were in lockdown again from January 2021 closing to all except KW and V pupils
A7	The organisation of bubbles makes it more difficult to provide interventions where we have mixed pupils across classes or year groups
A8	The pupils have less access to extra-curricular provision which helps to support their emotional & social development and well-being
