<p><b><u>Suggested Activities</u></b> Links to stories, rhymes and vocabulary lists are uploaded to Seesaw each week. Choose at least one of these suggested activities to complete each week.</p> <p><b><u>Reading</u></b> Share a book with an adult at least 4 times a week.</p> <p>Reception only: from after the autumn half term, continue to share a book with an adult as well as be listened to read at least 3 times a week recording it in their reading diaries.</p>	<p><b><u>Home Discovery Menu</u></b> Choose at least one idea from the menu of activities that is uploaded to Seesaw within the first week of each half term. Complete the project over the course of the half term. What they have created will be shared in class.</p> <p><b><u>Reading</u></b> Be read to or listened to reading for around 10 minutes at least 4 times a week with an adult and record it in their reading diaries.</p>	<p><b><u>Home Discovery Menu</u></b> Choose at least one idea from the menu of activities that is uploaded to Seesaw within the first week of each half term. Complete the project over the course of the half term. What they have created will be shared in class.</p> <p><b><u>Reading</u></b> Read for around 20 minutes at least 4 times a week with an adult and/or independently and record it in their reading diaries.</p> <p><b><u>Times Tables Rock Stars</u></b> Play Garage, Jamming, Studio and Soundcheck games on TT Rock Stars for 10 minutes at least 4 times a week. It can be accessed by downloading the app or going through the internet. Each child has their own log-in details. If they need a reminder of what these are, please see their teacher.</p>
