

P.E. at Teignmouth Primary

Our vision is to create a school which values Physical Education, Daily Physical Activity and School Sport and places this at the heart of the children's learning with a commitment to lifelong fitness, health and well-being. We aim to ensure that all children's experiences of physical activity are enjoyable and meaningful, enabling them to achieve and progress to their maximum potential. We actively encourage high standards in Physical Education, Daily Physical Activity and School Sports, through developing exemplary practice in teaching and learning, effective leadership and management and expert advice and support from Dartmoor School Sports Partnership. Physical education is the planned, progressive learning timetabled in our school curriculum delivered to all pupils. The context for the learning is physical activity, with children experiencing a broad range of activities including sport and dance. Daily physical activity includes indoor and outdoor play, outdoor and adventurous activities, active travel, routine activities and exercises throughout the school day. School sport is structured learning that takes place outside the curriculum. This is sometimes referred to as out of school hours learning. The school sport programme develops and broadens the learning in physical education and gives opportunities for community sport and activity.

Our aim is to develop and instil children to be active, energetic, confident, self-motivated, resilient, responsible and reflective individuals and leaders, who are able to use and value physical activity within their lives in preparation for living in a competitive, challenging and diverse world.

At Teignmouth Primary, P.E. and school sport are valued as an important part of our broad, varied and inclusive curriculum. D.P.A. (Daily Physical Activity) is encouraged in all classes and viewed as a positive opportunity for the children to have a break from other learning whilst improving their fitness and energy levels. As well as our pupils' physical development we are dedicated to improving our pupil's mental well-being and this is incorporated within our P.E. lessons.

Our yearly membership buy-in to the Dartmoor Sports Partnership allows us access to a range of sports coaches who support us in delivering high quality teaching to the children in a range of different sports. The School Sports Coordinator, designated to our school, comes into the school each term and works with teaching staff and support staff, improving the delivery of P.E. lessons and introducing classes to new, exciting activities. We attend their organised competitive and non-competitive events each term: funfests, multi skills events, tournaments and festivals. This allows our children to work alongside children from other schools, represent our school in performances and competitions. Teaching and support staff have access to a variety of CPD through the regular courses and INSET provided through the partnership each term.
